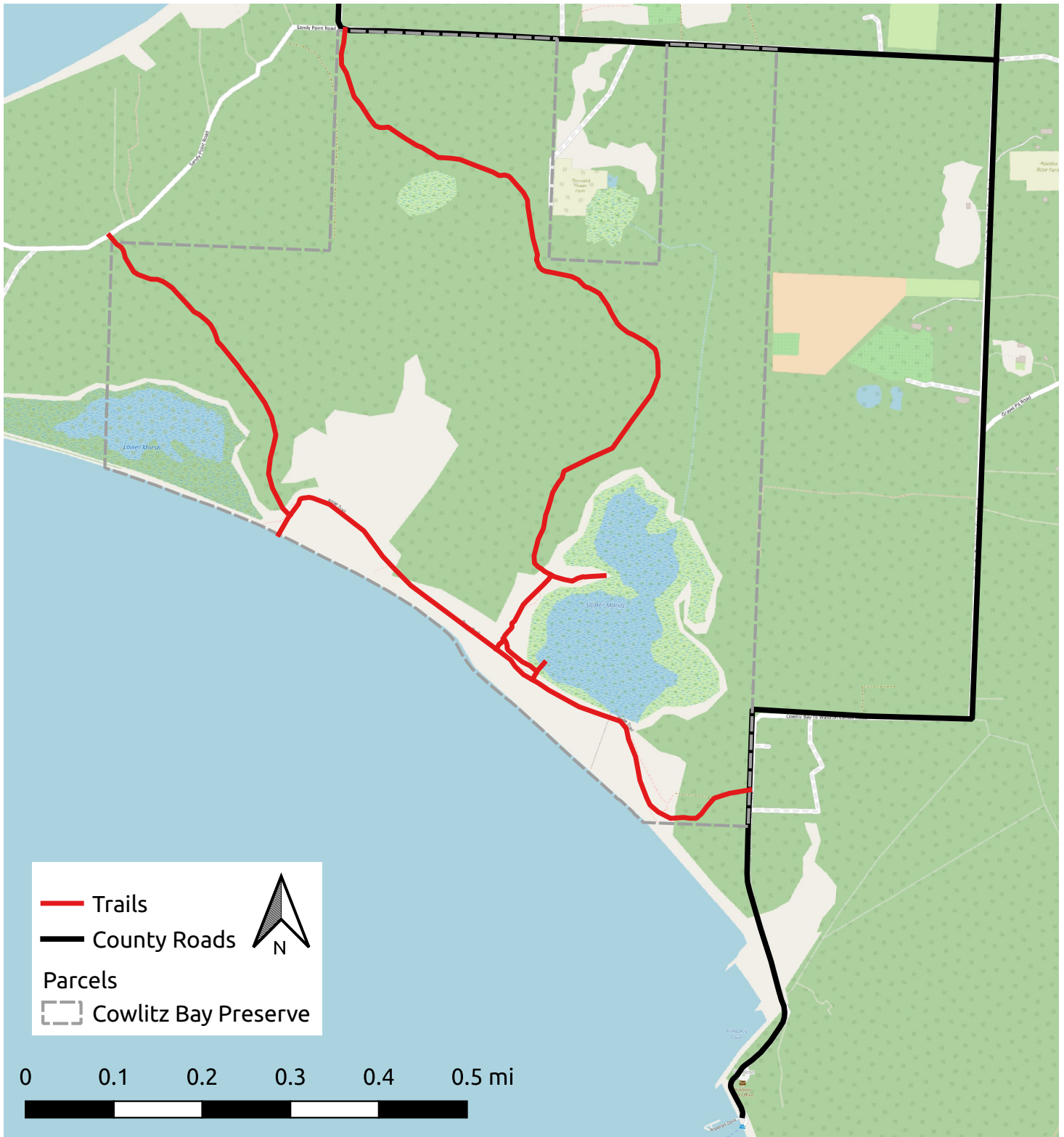


# Unofficial Cowlitz Bay Preserve Map

Waldon Island, WA



## Notes:

- San Juan Preservation Trust recommends that the preserve be accessed by anchoring in Cowlitz bay. There is only one point of trail access from the beach.
- It is possible to walk from the county dock to the preserve without trespassing on private property since the county road forms the southeast boundary of the preserve. However, it is said that the Waldronites will untie the dock lines of the boats of uninvited visitors and leave them to drift away.
- The trails in the preserve form a loop through a private road (Sandy Point Road) outside the boundary of the preserve. It is best to walk this loop clockwise since the trail intersection at the north is much more distinct than the intersection to the south. The intersection to the north is right after a turn in the county road and has a wooden board bridge into the preserve. However, you are likely to be accosted by Waldronites if you are caught walking on this road.
